Did you know that CAGPO provides a scholarship program designed to support physicians who would like to develop their skills in cancer care?

The learning activity takes the form of a clinical traineeship of one to four weeks duration. The value of the scholarship is up to \$4500 per full-time week of training. Applicants must be CAGPO members at the time of application.

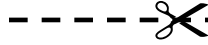
